

SIMON HERRMANN – Germany Male Cableski Athlete of the Decade 2010 - 2019



Since the age of 6, Simon has been obsessed with Cableski. He has been involved in competing, coaching, operating and engineering.

In the period from 2010-2020 he took part as Slalom Specialist in nearly all cableski competitions, whether they were Tiled Events, International Calendar or National Events. It was a rare event where he did not reach the podium.

His Nickname is *Slalom Machine*, because he is a real stylist and effortlessly rounds buoys - like train on rails. Simon defined the Slalom technique of how to pass the corner efficiently. He has always been the Skier to beat !

In the last decade Simon won at least :

- 1 World Championship Title
- 3 EA Championship Titles

In addition he broke the World Record 2 times and is still the current World Record Holder with a score of 4@9,50m!

Simon is a true sportsman and always happy to share his skills. Regardless of previous level or experience he is happy to be teaching and coaching all interested people. This makes him something of an idol to many young skiers. Simon is a real Team Player.

In recent years Simon has diversified from pure competing. He has trained as a professional technical expert on cable installations. He serves the sport as an operator on World Cups, Special Events and as a maintenance specialist all around the world.
