

## JULIA RICK – Germany Female Wakeboard Cable Rider of the Decade 2010 – 2019



Julia has dominated Cable Wakeboarding throughout this decade, she has become an exceptional role model for young girls across our sport and actively encourages girls to push themselves within our sport.

Julia entered her first ever World Championships in 2012 in the Junior Ladies category and absolutely smashed it, becoming the Junior Ladies World Champion, she then became a Professional Wakeboarder in 2013 after giving up Football, and has since won both 2016 & 2018 Open Ladies World Championships.

She holds 3 x World Championship titles during the decade.

On winning the latest 2018 World Championships in Argentina Julia said:

It definitely is an important victory because the IWWF Worlds only takes place every two years. Furthermore, I became **IWWF World Champion** for the 3rd time (2012 Junior, 2016 & 18 Open Ladies)!
